MGT 237 Formal Writing Assignment

MGT 237 is designated as a Writing Intensive (WI) course where students are required to use the writing process to complete a longer essay assignment (at least 12 pages). Students will (1) construct a working thesis and outline, (2) compose a rough draft, (3) participate in peer review, and (4) revise their rough drafts into a final draft.

Assignment Requirements

- A formal research paper totaling 12 pages
- APA style formatting and documentation
- Minimum 8 scholarly sources
- Rough draft and peer review
- Final draft due day 7 of Week 5
- No more than 20% of your essay can be quoted from another source; therefore, at least 80% of the content must be original. Refer to the TurnItIn originality report via the Dropbox for your originality score.

Topic choices

Choose one of the following topics based on course assignments:

- <u>Cultural differences and business communications</u> based on Individual Assignment 1 and In-class Activity 1a.
- <u>Effective Formal Communication Networks</u> based on Chapter 1 reading assignment and In-class Activity 1b
- Leadership styles based on In-Class Activity 2b and Individual Assignment 2.
- Groupthink based on Discussion Forum 2.
- <u>Effectiveness of virtual teams</u> based on In class Activity 2a.

Analyze the topic and **argue your opinion or perspective**. You must have a point; do not simply report on the topic. Your ideas should be expressed in an interesting and original manner.
