- 2-3 pages in MLA format
- Clearly defined
 - Opening- What is the problem or issue? Clearly define thesis (main point)
 - Body- What are your arguments? Use facts and possibly facts that appeal to emotions. What are the counter arguments and what is your answer to the counter arguments?
 - Conclusion- Call to action: What can we do? Clearly expressed goals Legal reform: public awareness: etc)
- Use figurative language
- Use oratorical devices such as refrain and hyperbole
- Bibliography (three sources minimum)
