There are better options for managing inventory that will reduce wait times and increase customer satisfaction.

Decisions need to be made in order to keep Wormy Orchard competitive in the new global market and make Wormy Orchard an even better place for families to come and visit. As a general worker for Wormy Orchard with a background in business, I believe my insight may be of use in looking at possible changes. There are a variety of account software programs available that could help Wormy Orchard and I would like to analyze the cost and benefits of three well-known programs: QuickBooks, Sage 50 and Xero.
