





The trees act as wind and sound buffers and this will also cut down traffic noise levels

Circular areas as the centre of the site, offers spaces for certain activities, such as a small concert, performances and ceremonies. It also provides a play grounds.

Coach stop enables quick access and it should be very easy to identify due to new location. It also gives this square as a waiting area for arrival and departures.

Water fountains gives life to the area. The water compared to the sea sound, creates identity and function.

Waiting, resting and play areas will incorporate sound Absorbers to minimise noise transmission to the square

The entire space use ramp instead of stairs to aid access for all and to avoid any kind of discrimination, two people which those in a wheelchair and those walking are not separated.
